- A. Quasi-Judicial Public Hearing:
- 1. Alderman Oaks (727 Hudson Avenue) (Continued from July 9, 2025): Rezone Application No. 25-REN-03 request for Rezone without Site Plan approval to Rezone the subject property with a street address of 727 Hudson Avenue from Residential Multiple Family 5 (RMF-5) Zone District to Downtown Edge (DTE) Zone District. The Future Land Classification for the site is Urban Edge. (Tom Sacharski, AICP, Planner, Development Services)
- 2. Main Street Monument Sign (1600 Main Street) (Continued from July 9, 2025): Planning Board Adjustment Application No. 25-ADP-08 request for application seeking a Planning Board Adjustment to allow for two monument ground signs located on designated primary streets within the Downtown Core (DTC) Zone District. The property has a Future Land Use Designation of Downtown Core. (Tom Sacharski, AICP, Planner, Development Services)
- 3. Florida Studio Theater Artist Wing (1221, 1233, and 1247 1st Street) (Continued from July 9, 2025): Planning Board Adjustment Application No. 24-ADP-07 request for Planning Board Adjustment approval to allow for a ceiling height of less than 12 feet on the first floor, two additional marquee signs, one additional building identification sign, increased height to the building identification signage, and parking within the second layer along a designated primary grid street for the proposed Florida Studio Theater Artist Wing on Subject Property with street addresses of 1221, 1233, and 1247 1st Street. - **4. Rhodes and Aspinwall (351 North Rhodes Avenue):** Rezone with Site Plan, and final Plat Subdivision Application **Nos. 24-SP-11, 24-RE-02, and 24-SUB-02** request for



Rezone with Site Plan and Subdivision approval to develop a 17-unit, single-family attached townhome project on an approximately 1.35-acre parcel with a street address of 351 N. Rhodes Avenue. Each townhome will be located on its own platted lot of approximately 1,699 square feet. The subject property has a Future Land Use (FLU) Classification of Urban Mixed Use. The applicant is also requesting approval to rezone the property from the Office Regional District (ORD) Zone District to the Mixed Use 1 (MU-1) Zone District. Vehicular access is proposed via a driveway for each unit accessible from Rhodes Avenue. All units are proposed as attainable.

5. Marie Selby Botanical Gardens (1534 Mound Street): Site Plan Application **No. 25-SP-09** request for Site Plan approval to redevelop approximately 3.96 acres of the 14.73-acre subject site with a street address of 1534 Mound Street. The redevelopment will replace 17,164 square feet of greenhouses, a 3,370-square foot admissions building, a 2,300-square foot plant shop, and 1,340 square feet of accessory buildings with a 35,770-square foot conservatory and a 2,725-square foot learning pavilion. New pedestrian paths are also proposed to create a coordinated network of pathways. No changes to the vehicular access or parking are proposed.
